IPSA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

I. Scholarship Eligibility:

1. The applicant must be a bona fide student of IPSA;
2. Must be of good academic standing with a general average of not lower than **85%** during the 1st Qtr Academic Period SY 2010-2011 and shall maintain a satisfactory grade within the duration of the scholarship coverage;
3. The combined family income (husband and wife) shall not be higher than **SR 5,000.00** (Five Thousand Saudi Riyals) per month;
4. The applicant belongs to a family of two (2) children or more all studying in IPSA;
5. The applicant is not a recipient of any scholarship grant from other sponsors or their parents do not receive educational assistance from their company/employer.
6. All applicants must meet and maintain the requirements for eligibility and must pass the evaluation process, unless otherwise outlined in this policy.

II. General Scholarship Information:

1. The beneficiaries of IPSA Scholarship Program for free tuition fee during this School Year 2010-2011 will be as follows:
 - One (1) eligible pupil from Pre-Elementary
 - One (1) eligible pupil from Lower Elementary
 - One (1) eligible student from Upper Elementary
 - One (2) eligible students from High School
2. All submissions and inquiries must be directed to the Office of the School Principal for proper disposition. The IPSA Scholarship Program Committee will review and recommend eligible pupils / students for the scholarship grant based on approved guidelines and criteria.
3. The scholarship recipient shall behave or act appropriately. Any disciplinary action taken against him/her may result to the termination of the scholarship grant.
4. The IPSA Scholarship Program Committee reserves the right to review and cancel the scholarship grant at any time due to changes in financial resources of the donor or recipient, residency, failure to pay other school fees in the prescribed period or due to the recipient's failure to remain in good academic or behavioral standing.
5. The scholar shall maintain an average grade of **85%** in any grading period during the academic school year. Otherwise, the scholarship grant will be terminated and the remaining grant during the school year will be transferred to the other eligible candidate.
6. In case there is a tie of qualified and eligible candidates, the IPSA Scholarship Program Committee shall initiate a tie-breaker by drawing of lots to determine the scholarship recipient in each grade/year level. The candidates for scholarship program will draw the lot of the final recipient/scholar.
7. The Scholarship Program Committee will notify all applicants who will be awarded with scholarship grant upon completion of the evaluation and qualification process. Likewise, notice will be given to applicants who fail to qualify for the scholarship grant.
8. Applicants who did not qualify for the school year's scholarship grant may re-apply or re-file the application in the next school year should the program continue in the subsequent academic school year.
9. All applicants must comply with the guidelines and requirements. Failure to comply will result to disqualification of the applicant.
10. The beneficiaries or scholars of IPSA Scholarship Program are for the current school year only. All eligible candidates must renew their application for the subsequent school year should the scholarship program continue based on the availability of sponsors.
11. Applicants shall be responsible in obtaining and submitting all required information and Application Form (PS-22) to the Office of the School Principal. All applications and accompanying supporting information shall become the property of the IPSA Scholarship Program Committee. The decision of the IPSA Scholarship Committee on scholarship grant is final.
